


WHERE FRIENDSHIPS & ADVENTURES BEGIN!

SPECIALTY PROGRAMMES



FOREST SCHOOL - 10 weekly hours (ages 8-14)

We believe in giving students an opportunity to learn about and appreciate their natural surroundings. Campers will explore nature, learn about different plant life and wildlife while consciously considering the global environment and our daily impacts.

- Geared toward all levels of English proficiency
- Classes take place outdoors (weather permitting)
- Instructors use natural surroundings to help students build confidence, language ability and respect for the environment



- 10 weekly hours (ages 15-16)

The Swallowdale Leadership Training course is aimed at campers aged 15-16 with a good command of English. Participants develop leadership, teamwork, and communication skills through workshops and practical activities, while fully enjoying camp life.
