### GENERAL ENGLISH - 15 weekly hours

General English is the choice for most international students. This option provides classroom instruction in speaking, listening, reading and writing, with a focus on helping students of all proficiency levels to improve in their fluency and accuracy of speech.

## GLOBAL LEADERSHIP - 20 weekly hours

Global Leadership offers specialized lessons delivered by expert staff. The intent is to guide participants to effectively lead others while inspiring passion and change within themselves and the ever-changing world around them.

#### **PROJECT PREPARATION**

Throughout the course, students collaborate on a final project while strengthening their presentation skills. In the final lesson, they showcase their passion projects, confidently presenting their ideas and leadership vision to their peers.

- 3-week sessions (Jun 28 Jul 18 or Jul 19 Aug 08)
- Specialized instructors (IELTS 4.0+ required)
- Maximum class size = 20 students
