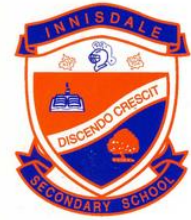
Mission Statement:

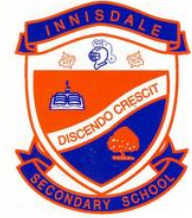
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includes English, Politics, World History, Philosophy and Visual Art. During the semester students may travel to a developing country for two weeks and to Germany for the final month.



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
