

Please read the following terms of release of claims, waiver of liability and compensation, as well as the responsibilities of the student.

1. GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1.1 Any inaccuracy in the application is grounds for the CSCNO to terminate the agreement and send the student back to his home country, without reimbursement and at the expense of the student's parents.
- 1.2 The CSCNO and the host school cannot be held liable for losses or expenses arising from labour disputes, inclement weather, or other events beyond their control.
- 1.3 The CSCNO is a French language Catholic school board. The Board commits to an education where students may live their citizenship and their commitment to Catholicity and francophone culture.
- 1.4 Although Canada and the Greater City of Sudbury are considered very safe destinations, and that all reasonable measures are taken by CSCNO to ensure the student's safety during his stay, the CSCNO cannot guarantee the student's safety. The CSCNO, its directors, employees, agents, volunteers and representatives shall not be held liable for any injury, including injuries resulting in death, that a student could sustain while participating in the program.

2. AS THE PARENT OR GUARDIAN OF THE STUDENT, I UNDERSTAND THAT:

- 2.1 I authorize the CSCNO to use the photo / video / testimony of my child for promotional or informational purposes. I understand that photos, videos, or stories of my child may be published in documents such as (but not limited to) advertisements in newspapers and on television, information on websites and Facebook pages linked to the school board or to its schools, brochures, internal newsletters such as Capsules, etc.
- 2.2 I release from all liability and agree to compensate the CSCNO for any loss or damage to equipment, expenses, suits, claims, and expenses and fees of any nature arising from the student's participation in the program and that, regardless of the cause, including any act, omission, negligent conduct, or intentional conduct on the part of CSCNO.
- 2.3 In the event I attempt to file a lawsuit against the CSCNO, I expressly acknowledge that the CSCNO will be free to choose the jurisdiction in which this action will take place, regardless of my place of residence, my citizenship or my home country. By signing this agreement, I recognize that the Canadian and / or Ontario laws apply to and govern any legal procedure.

3. AS A STUDENT, I UNDERSTAND THAT I MUST:

- 3.1 Respect federal, provincial, and municipal laws; CSCNO regulations; the Provincial Code of conduct as well as the rules of the school I will be attending, at all times. Failure to do this may result in immediate dismissal from the school and the program, and my return to my home country, at my own expense and without any possibility of refund.
- 3.2 Immediately inform CSCNO of any change in my contact information.
- 3.3 Attend my classes diligently. Obey my teachers and any person in authority, including my guardians, and / or my host family.
- 3.4 Make every effort required to properly complete my school work. I understand that the CSCNO is a French School Board, and that the language used in all classes and school activities is French.
- 3.5 Allow my parents and / or legal tutor, as well as my host family, to have access to my school grades and report cards.
