

Five Month and Ten-Month Programs

If you are attending school in British Columbia for five months or ten months, select the courses you are interested in and that meet the requirements from your home country.

- For **Five Month Programs**, select a total of <u>7 courses</u> and place them in order of preference from 1 to 7. Choose the courses from both the Academic Courses and Elective Courses lists.
 - You will receive 4 courses. Three additional courses are selected to provide flexibility in scheduling.
- For **Ten Month Programs**, select a total of <u>11 courses</u> and place them in order of preference from 1 to 11. Choose the courses from both the Academic Courses and Elective Courses lists.
 - You will receive 8 courses. Three additional courses are selected to provide flexibility in scheduling.

British Columbia Graduation Programs

If you plan to graduate in British Columbia

- Refer to the Graduation Requirements Chart on the Course Selection Information Pages.
- Select the required Academic courses for your grade level.
- In grades 11 and 12, you may select more than one course from each Academic area.
- Select the pre-requisite courses required for admission to the program you wish to study at University
- Select the elective courses you are interested in. To graduate in British Columbia, you are required to take at least one course that is either an Arts Education course or a Design, Skills and Technology course.
- Select a total of <u>11 courses</u> and place them in order of preference from 1 to 11. Three additional courses
 are selected to provide flexibility in scheduling. Be sure to list your required courses first and then your
 elective courses.

Students will receive courses based on:

- Selected areas of interest
- Space availability
- Scheduling conflicts
