- 4. Coordination of entrance testing & student interviews by Skype® or telephone, as part of application process if required
- 5. Collection and delivery of school Letter of Acceptance following payment of fees

RESPONSIBILTY OF HOST / CLIENT

- Ensuring that the person who will host the student is able/willing to AND meets eligibilty to be a Canadian custodian
- 2. Obtaining valid and notarized Custodial Declaration documents (per *Canadian Citizenship & Immigration outline*)
- 3. Airport meet & greet + transfer to the host home/return
- 4. Accompanying the student to the school for:
 - Mandatory assessments
 - Mandatory orientations
- 5. Ensuring the student understands how to get to/from school
- Assisting student to confirm courses meet any academic and/or covalidation needs as well as approving any course changes
- 7. Signing permission forms for school-related trips and activities
- 8. Communicating with the natural family about student's cultural and academic acclimatization
- 9. Handling any school discipline or legal issues that arise from student's behaviour or activity
- 10. Generally being responsible for student's well-being and comfort during the programme duration
- 11. Covalidation of student transcripts upon completion of 5 or 10 month school programme
